

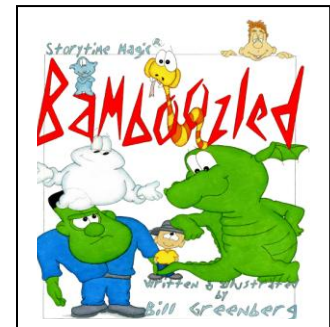

- * Pretend that you don't know how it got there; just imagine that it suddenly appeared one minute ago.
- * Make up a story about how the object got there and why.
- * Now have something in a closed box. Imagine what might be inside. Shake the box up and down; and sideways. The sound may help you come up with ideas.
- * Make up a story about the mystery object in the box and the object that appeared high on the shelf. How did they both suddenly appear? Let your story be a little crazy and fun!
