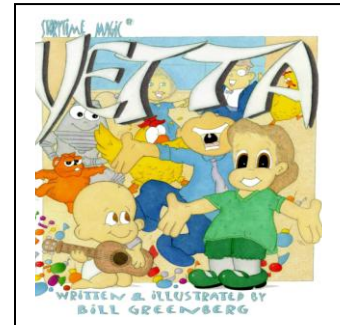


Activity 3

Woosh! Flower petals are plopping all over stepdad, stepbrother, step baby, step robot, step chicken, and stepladder again. Yetta is so hyper that she's ruining *everything* with her jumping, running, twisting, singing, dancing and laughing in the middle of a wedding?

Authors get lots of ideas from the world around them. Even Yetta, (in this book) got new ideas each time she heard music (she moved; and jumped; and ran; and twisted; and sang, and danced; and laughed; which are all action verbs). Do sounds ever make you feel like doing something?

Think of the sounds around you . . . and see if they “move” you. Talk about, write or draw a picture to show all the sounds you can think of:

- * Sounds made by machines (heating, clock, etc.)
- * Sounds made by people
- * Animals sounds
- * Musical sounds
- * Sounds made inside
- * Sounds made outside
- * Sounds you can hear with both ears plugged

Talk about, write or draw pictures to show how some sounds make you feel (emotions); or, what you feel like doing (action verbs) when you hear certain sounds.
